

GRACE Ministries

GRACE Ministries is a mission project through the United Methodist Church that serves low-income families in our local community. It provides the opportunity to share the gospel of God's love through monthly distributions of food donated by the Department of Agriculture and CUMC, clothing (seasonally-appropriate clothing for infants, children, youth and adults), diapers, formula, toys, books, and household items. GRACE Ministries accepts donations on the Friday prior to the day of distribution between 2:30pm – 6:00pm. Items can be dropped off in bins provided to the left of the Sanctuary.

Volunteers are essential to the running of GRACE Ministries. Volunteer opportunities are available on the 2nd Saturday of each month. Volunteers should arrive no later than 7:45am to assist with distribution and preparation. The various areas of opportunity to serve include setting up and organizing assigned rooms, running between rooms to assist with coverage, guiding people around packaging and loading food into carts, helping people load their cars, and tearing down and cleaning out of rooms. Children who are 10 years and older are encouraged to participate. Children between the ages of 10-12 must be accompanied by an adult. Volunteering at GRACE Ministries also serves as a great way for students to fulfill required community service hours for school.
