Sunday Message

Bible Passage: Job 1; 2; 13; 40; 42

Main Point: God doesn’t always take away sad times.

Key Passage: Philippians 4:13

“I can do all this through him who gives me strength.”

This Sunday, the children will learn that God doesn’t always take away sad times. Job is the righteous man, but Satan thinks that’s only because he is happy and wealthy. God allows Satan to take away Job’s wealth and family. Job is a very sad for a long time. God doesn’t always take away sad times, but after a while he give back everything Job lost, plus more.

All kids have experienced sadness. Although this point may sound discouraging, it is an encouragement for kids. We will help them see that even when sad times don’t go away, God is with us in the midst of them. And like Job, we can stand strong in our faith during sad times.
