## Sunday Message

Bible Passage: Ephesians 6:1-3

Main Point: Honor their mother

Key Passage: 2 Corinthians 5:17

*“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!”*

*This Sunday, the children will learn about what it means to honor their mothers. We will also help children develop an attitude of appreciations for their mothers. What does it mean to have a right attitude, what kind of attitude God wants us to have toward our parents? We will take a close look at Hannah, mother of Samuel. The love and promise she made to God regarding Samuel.*

**Matthew 15:4-6** *For God said, ‘Honor your father and mother’ and ‘Anyone who curses their father or mother is to be put to death.’ But you say that if anyone declares that what might have been used to help their father or mother is ‘devoted to God,’ they are not to ‘honor their father or mother’ with it. Thus you nullify the word of God for the sake of your tradition.*

**Exodus 20:12** *“Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.*

**Proverbs 6:20-22** *My son, keep our father’s command and do not forsake your mother’s teaching. Bind them always on your heart; fasten them around your neck. When you walk, they will guide you; when you sleep, they will watch over you; when you awake, they will speak to you.*
